Regulation Description	<p>1. Operated an electrical contracting business without being the holder of an electrical contractor license, contrary to s.3 of O. Reg. 570/05, and did thereby commit an offence contrary to ss.113.20(1)(a) of the Electricity Act, 1998 (“Act”).</p> <p>Vince Turano was sentenced to a fine of \$10,000.</p> <p>2. As a director or officer of Turano’s Home Improvement Ltd. (“THI”), Vince Turano was convicted of two (2) counts of failing to take all reasonable care to prevent THI from committing an offence under ss.113.20(2) of the Act, contrary to ss.113.20(3) of the Act.</p> <p>Vince Turano was sentenced to a fine of \$2,000 per count, for a total of \$4,000.</p>
Description of Contravention	<p>Vince Turano (“Turano”) was the sole officer and Director of Turano’s Home Improvement Ltd. (“THI”).</p> <p>In 2019 THI Was contracted to conduct renovations at a residential property located in Burlington, work which was to include electrical work. Afterwords, however, several electrical defects were discovered in the electrical work completed by THI, and the consumer paid an additional \$4,500 for the defects to be corrected by a licensed electrical contractor.</p>



Administrative Action Summary

Additional Information	Turano and THI were both acquitted of two (2) counts each under the Electricity Act, 1998. On appeal, however, those counts were overturned.
