NOTICE REGARDING TRAINING AND MASTER ELECTRICIAN EXAMS

Safety & Technical Training

As the government continues a gradual, staged approach to reopen Ontario, ESA is assessing how we can safely resume in-person classroom training while adhering to Ontario Public Health guidelines. ESA is continuing to monitor key public health indicators and Stage 3 restrictions as efforts begin to reschedule previously postponed in-person classroom courses.

If you are registered in a postponed ESA course, we will notify you in the next couple of weeks of the rescheduled date. Please note that online courses are continuing as scheduled.

Master Electrician Examinations

ESA continues to assess how we can safely offer the Master Electrician (ME) examination while adhering to Ontario Public Health guidelines. ESA is working on resuming in-person exam sessions, as well as implementing Virtual Proctoring for ME exams in the fall.

Courses and exams will be rescheduled when public health officials advise transmission concerns have subsided. We will continue to review all procedures for the health and safety of our customers, employees and the community.

If you registered for a postponed ESA training course or ME Examination, we will notify you of the rescheduled date once it's determined.
