<b>Regulation Description</b>	<p>1. Proposed to carry out an activity referred to in the regulations under the Act as requiring an authorization, by placing an advertisement for electrical work on Facebook.com and on a website, babaandsonsbuilder.com, contrary to ss. 113.2(1) of the Electricity Act, 1998.</p> <p>Baba&amp;Sons Builders Inc. was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$3,000.</p> <p>2. Operated an electrical contracting business without being the holder of an electrical contractor license, contrary to s. 3 of O.Reg. 570/05.</p> <p>Baba&amp;Sons Builders Inc. was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$5,000.</p> <p>3. Permitted / employed a person to carry out an activity referred to in the regulations as requiring an authorization without that person being authorized to carry out said activity in accordance with Part VIII of the Electricity Act, 1998, and the regulations made thereunder, contrary to ss. 113.2(1) of the Electricity Act, 1998.</p> <p>Baba&amp;Sons Builders Inc. was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$5,000.</p>

<b>Description of Contravention</b>	<p>Baba&amp;Sons Builders Inc. is not the holder of an electrical contractor license and so was not authorized to operate as an electrical contracting business nor propose (advertise) to carry out electrical work.</p> <p>Between January 1, 2023, and January 31, 2023, BBS operated itself as an electrical contracting business. BBS also advertised to carry out electrical work on Facebook and a website, babaandsonsbuilders.com. BBS also permitted / employed a person to propose to carry out electrical work at a residential property when that person was not authorized (licensed) under the Electricity Act, 1998, to do so.</p>
