Limited, without being the holder of an electrical contractor license, contrary to s. 3 of Ontario Regulation 570/05: Licensing of Electrical Contractors and Master Electricians. Burrell Overhead Door Co. Limited was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$5,000.00.2. Prior to the commencement of work to be done on an electrical installation at a commercial property in Pickering, Ontario, failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority a Notification of Work, contrary to Rule 2-004(1)(a) of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code. Burrell Overhead Door Co. Limited was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$5,000.00.3. Permitted or employed someone to carry out electrical work, which is an activity referred to in the regulations under the Act as requiring an authorization, who was not authorized to do so, contrary to ss. 113.2(1) of the Electricity Act, 1998. Burrell Overhead Door Co. Limited was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$5,000.00.

Limited, ("Burrell"), was not authorized (licensed) to operate an electrical contracting business.</p> <p>Between July 1, 2023 and July 19, 2023, Burrell operated an electrical contracting business, Burrell Overhead Door Co. Limited, without being the holder of an electrical contractor license.</p> <p>Between July 1, 2023 and July 19, 2023, and prior to the commencement of work to be done on an electrical installation at a commercial property in Pickering, Ontario, Burrell failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority a Notification of Work, colloquially known as a 'Permit'.</p> <p>Burrell is not authorized to propose, permit, or employ to carry out electrical work.</p> <p>Between July 1, 2023 and July 19, 2023, Burrell permitted or employed someone who was not authorized (licensed) to carry out electrical work, which is an activity referred to in the regulations under the Act as requiring an authorization.</p>
