Description of Contravention	EZ Renos Inc. is not authorized (licensed) under the Electricity Act, 1998.
	Between December 1, 2022, and May 31, 2023, EZ Renos Inc. permitted or employed an unlicensed individual to carry out electrical work at a residential property in Oakville, Oakville, when that person was not authorized to do so. As part of the electrical work that was being done, EZ Renos Inc. failed to file with Electrical Safety Authority a notification (i.e. a permit) for the electrical work.
	Additionally, between March 1, 2025, and March 21, 2025, EZ Renos Inc. placed advertisements for electrical work on its website EZRenos.ca.
