Regulation Description	1. Operated an electrical contracting business without being the holder of an electrical contractor license, contrary to s. 3 of O.Reg. 570/05: Licensing of Electrical Contractors and Master Electricians. Hamid Mahmood was ordered to pay an administrative penalty in the amount of \$5,000. 2. Proposed to carry out an activity referred to in the regulations under the Act as requiring an authorization by providing an estimate or quote for electrical work, contrary to ss.113.2(1) of the <i>Electricity Act, 1998</i>. Hamid Mahmood was ordered to pay an administrative penalty in the amount of \$3,000. 3. Carried out an activity referred to in the regulations under the Act as requiring an authorization (license), by carrying out electrical work at a property in Burlington, Ontario, without being authorized, contrary to ss.113.2(1) of the <i>Electricity Act, 1998</i>. Hamid Mahmood was ordered to pay an administrative penalty in the amount of \$3,000. 4. Prior to the commencement of work to be done on an electrical installation at a property in Burlington, failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority, a Notification of the Work, contrary to Rule 2-004(1)(a) of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code.

Administrative Action Summary

	Hamid Mahmood was ordered to pay an administrative penalty in the amount of \$1,500.
Description of Contravention	Hamid Mahmood (“Mahmood”) was not authorized (licensed) under the <i>Electricity Act, 1998</i>. Between October 1, 2022, and December 31, 2022, Mahmood: operated an unlicensed electrical contracting business; provided an estimate or quote for electrical work at a Burlington property without being authorized; and failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority a Notification of the Work (i.e. a ‘Permit’), for the electrical work. Then, and between November 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022, Mahmood carried out electrical work at a Burlington property without being authorized.
