Knowingly held out as genuine any document, certificate, identification card, or any other document issued under Part VIII of the <i>Electricity Act</i> or regulations, and did thereby commit an offence contrary to s.113.20(1)(a) of the <i>Electricity Act</i>, 1998.</p> <p>Parminder Singh was fined \$6,000.</p>
Description of Contravention	<p>Parminder Singh (“Singh”) was employed by Skylark Electric Inc., held a 309A qualification, but was neither a Licensed Electrical Contractor (“LEC”) nor a Master Electrician (“ME”).</p> <p>Between January 24 and 27 of 2023, Singh completed electrical work for a renovation at a residential property in Caledon. After the work failed inspection, however, Singh sent a forged ‘Certificate of Acceptance’ to the general contractor, which was then forwarded to the homeowner.</p>
Additional Information	Initially, Singh denied providing any Certificate of Acceptance for the work. However, during the ESA’s investigation Singh admitted

	<p>that he did in fact forge the certificate, explaining that he was overseas at the time and was unable to correct the defects. He claimed that he provided the forged certificate from a previous job, not intending to deceive anyone but to provide reassurance the general contractor and homeowner.</p>
