<b>Administrative Action</b>	Administrative Penalty
<b>Location</b>	Blandford Blenheim, Ontario and St. Thomas, Ontario
<b>Regulation Description</b>	<p>1. Contravened an Order issued by the Electrical Safety Authority under ss. 113(11) of the Electricity Act, 1998.</p> <p>Reliance Home Comfort Limited Partnership was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$4,000.</p> <p>2. Prior to the commencement of work to be done on an electrical installation at a residential property in St. Thomas, Ontario, failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority, a Notification of Work, contrary to Rule 2-004(1)(a) of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code.</p> <p>Reliance Home Comfort Limited Partnership was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$4,000.</p>
<b>Description of Contravention</b>	<p>Reliance Home Comfort Limited Partnership, (“<b>Reliance</b>”), is a limited partnership in the Province of Ontario.</p> <p>On March 19, 2024, the Electrical Safety Authority, (“<b>ESA</b>”), ordered Reliance to correct electrical defect(s), none of which posed a hazard to ‘life and/or property’, (“<b>Order</b>”). Reliance, however, contravened the Order after failing to correct the electrical defects at a residential property in Blandford Blenheim, Ontario, as ordered by the ESA.</p>

## Administrative Action Summary

	Between June 1, 2024 and June 30, 2024, Reliance carried out electrical work at a residential property in St. Thomas, Ontario. In doing so, Reliance failed to file with the ESA, a Notification of Work, colloquially known as a permit.
