Did operate an electrical contracting business without being the holder of an electrical contractor license, contrary to section 3 of Ontario Regulation 570/05, and did thereby commit an offence contrary to section 113.20(1)(a) of the Electricity Act;</p> <p>Sadadsaralingham Nagamany was convicted and sentenced to a fine of \$6,000.00</p> <p>2. Did fail to file with ESA a Notification of Work for an electrical installation, as required by the provisions of Rule 2-004(1) of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code, adopted by reference in Ontario Regulation 164/99, as amended, and did thereby commit an offence contrary to section 113(12)(b) of the Electricity Act</p> <p>Sadadsaralingham Nagamany was convicted and sentenced to a fine of \$3,000.00</p> <p>3. Did install electrical equipment with insufficient guarding to adequately provide for the safety of persons, property, and the protection of the electrical equipment, contrary to Rule 2-200 of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code, adopted by reference in Ontario Regulation 164/99, and did thereby commit an offence contrary to s.113(12)(b) of the Electricity Act.</p> <p>Sadadsaralingham Nagamany was convicted and fined \$6,000.00</p>
Description of Contravention	Between December 1, 2021 and January 31, 2022, Sadadsaralingham Nagamany (" Nagamany ") completed extensive electrical work at a residential property in Belleville.

Administrative Action Summary

	Nagamany was not a licensed electrical contractor at the time the work was completed. He did not obtain a Notification of Work prior to commencing the electrical work. Moreover, the electrical work performed by Nagamany contained several defects, two of which were considered hazardous such that the safety of persons and/or property was put at risk.
Additional Information	Nagamany was given 15 days to pay all fines.
