<p>Description of Contravention</p>	<p>Skender Demiri was not authorized (licensed) under the <i>Electricity Act, 1998</i>.</p> <p>Between January 1, 2024, and March 31, 2024, as part of the electrical work being performed at the five (5) properties, Skender Demiri failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority a Notification of the Work, (i.e. 'Permit') for the electrical work.</p> <p>In addition, Skender Demiri permitted or employed an unlicensed individual to carry out electrical work when that person was not authorized to do so.</p>
