Description of Contravention	<p>Stanley Lachapelle ("Lachapelle"), unlicensed, responded to two online advertisements seeking an electrician.</p> <p>Lachapelle attended each residence and completed electrical work. No Notifications of Work were obtained for the electrical work performed at either property. Defects were found in the electrical work performed.</p> <p>Lachapelle also provided a signed letter which purported to be an inspection letter, which he was not authorized to do. Lachapelle was paid for the electrical work completed on both homes and an additional fee for the provision of the letter.</p>
Additional Information	Lachapelle entered a plea to Counts and received a total fine of \$6,500. Lachapelle was given 1 year to pay his fines.
