Prior to the commencement of work to be done on an electrical installation in Mississauga, failed to file with Electrical Safety Authority a notification of the work, contrary to rule 2-004(1)(a) of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code.  Welmond Inc. was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$10,000.</li> <li>2. Proposed to carry out an activity referred to in the regulations under the Act as requiring an authorization, by proposing to carry out electrical work a property in Mississauga, contrary to ss.113.2(1) of the <i>Electricity Act, 1998</i>.  Welmond Inc. was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$10,000.</li> <li>3. (“<b>Welmond</b>”) is a provincial corporation which operates both as AGM Renovations and / or AGM Basements.</p> <p>Welmond does not hold a license as an electrical contractor.</p> <p>After proposing to carry out electrical work at a residential property in Mississauga, permitted or employed a person to carry out the electrical work when said person was not authorized (licensed). Prior to the commencement of this electrical work, Welmond failed to file with Electrical Safety Authority a notification (permit) for the work.</p>
