

Description of terms used for ESA's Review Panel Decisions

Name: The Individual and/or company who appealed a decision of an ESA Director to the ESA Review Panel or a decision of the ESA Review Panel to the Divisional Court.

Date: Date on which the matter was finally disposed, and the Review Panel or the Divisional Court rendered a decision.

Decision Type:

- 1) Administrative Penalty Order — A decision relating to an Administrative Penalty ordered by the ESA for a contravention of an Order, Notice of Proposal, or a prescribed contravention of the Act, Licensing Regulation, or the Ontario Electrical Safety Code (OESC).
- 2) Licensing — A decision relating to an ESA Notice of Proposal (or Provisional Notice in some urgent cases) to refuse, suspend, revoke, or impose conditions on an authorization (license).
- 3) Code – A decision relating to an ESA Order that pertains to non-compliance with the OESC that ESA determined is a risk to electrical safety.
- 4) Utility – A decision relating to actions ESA undertook for matters regulated under the Electrical Distribution Safety Regulation (Ontario Regulation 22/04).
- 5) Product Safety – A decision relating to actions ESA undertook for matter regulated under the Product Safety Regulation (Ontario Regulation 438/07).
- 6) Divisional Court – A decision made by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice in a statutory appeal relating to a decision of the Electrical Safety Authority Review Panel.
