## About ESA Licensing

The Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) is Ontario's electrical safety regulator. The Ontario government has given ESA a mandate to improve public electrical safety. We fulfill this mandate by undertaking a range of activities aimed at enhancing public safety, including but not limited to:

- ✓ Providing training

- ✓ Licensing Master Electricians (MEs) and Electrical Contractors (ECs)

- ✓ Administering the Master Electrician Exam

---

- ✓ Inspection (overseeing compliance with the Ontario Electrical Safety Code)

## About the Program

The Electrical Safety Authority (ESA), in partnership with Indigenous Skills, Employment, Apprenticeship, and Development (ISEAD), is offering a Licensing & Training Grant to support Indigenous journey person electricians in Ontario who are pursuing their Master Electrician (ME) licence. For applicants interested in starting their own electrical contracting business, the grant can also assist with obtaining an Electrical Contractor (EC) licence.

This program is designed to remove financial and informational barriers to licensing and support Indigenous entrepreneurship, economic development, and community leadership, and provide guidance and resources that make the licensing pathway clearer and easier to navigate.

## What the Grant Includes

The grant may cover:

- Guidance and support navigating the pathway to ESA licensure
- Online ESA Training Solutions Pre-Master Electrician Course, including course materials
- Master Electrician (ME) Exam fee
- First-year ME licence fee
- First-year Electrical Contractor (EC) licence fee (optional, for those interested in starting a business)
