## **MKE Industries Recalls Commercial Electrical Fryer Model FE-16M (A,B,C,D) Due to Potential Fire Hazard**

The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that MKE Industries has announced a voluntary recall of the following commercial product. Users should stop using recalled products immediately.

Name of Product: Electric Fryer

Units: 100 units

Manufacturer/Importer: MKE Industries  
Manufactured in: Canada

Hazard: The temperature probes in the unit are located in different positions than those on the unit that underwent safety certification. If the unit is used with a small amount of oil (just enough to reach the bottom elements) there is a risk that the oil will ignite.

Incidents/Injuries: No incidents reported.

Description/Models: All FE-16M that have been manufactured between 2010 and 2014. Sold by: Canadian commercial kitchen equipment distributors

When distributed: Between 2010 and 2014

Remedy: A technician will be sent on site to repair the unit.
