How to Prepare for Your Inspection

To whom it may concern,

ESA is using a wide range of options in order to inspect electrical installations. If an onsite inspection is determined to be required, the inspector may:

- Ask if anyone on the premise is unwell or has tested positive on a rapid test;
- Request that the inspection area be vacated or that the inspection be performed with at least 2 metres or 6 feet away from other people;
- Request that doors are opened and lights turned on before arrival;
- Leave used Personal Protective Equipment (i.e. Mask, gloves, etc.) in a disposal bag on site; and
- Take additional precautions, including disinfecting tools and practicing proper hand hygiene prior to your visit.
