

I see an outlet that has too many things plugged into it. We better tell an adult.






Every adventure needs a little snack!

Another electrical danger, caught by Carter!


What's in here?


That hairdryer is really close to the tub. Electrical devices should stay far away from water.



Look! The basement is being renovated! We should stay out of here.


Don't worry, my good friend Permit Pete is here to make sure the builders are being safe.






Look up!
