Disposition:	<p>On October 4, 2017, the Defendant entered a guilty plea to 4 counts as indicated below. On October 26, 2017, the Defendant appealed his own guilty plea and the sentence.</p> <p>The appeal was heard on April 11, 2018, by the Judge of the Ontario Court of Justice, Criminal Division.</p> <p>The Judge has affirmed the conviction but reduced the penalty, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) \$2,000 fine plus \$500 victim surcharge</li> <li>(2) \$2,000 fine plus \$500 victim surcharge</li> <li>(3) Suspended sentence</li> <li>(4) Suspended sentence</li> </ul>
