Regulation Description	 Operated an electrical contracting business without being a holder of an electrical contractor license, contrary to s.3 of O. Reg. 570/05. Daud was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$5,000. Failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority a Notification of Work for an electrical installation, contrary to Rule 2-004(1) of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code. Daud was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$1,300.
Description of Contravention	 Daud is not authorized by the Electrical Safety Authority to operate an electrical contracting business. A consumer in Whitby was renovating their residential property, looking to have both interior and exterior lighting installed as well as several receptacles. To that end Daud was subcontracted for the purpose of, and did thereafter engage in, electrical work at the property. The matter came to the ESA's attention after the consumer requested information that the electrical work was completed in compliance with the Electricity Act, 1998.
