Charge(s):	(1) Did propose to carry out activities of an electrical contracting business without being a holder of an electrical contractor license, by placing an advertisement on Kijiji online classified ads, contrary to s. 113.20(1)(d) of the <i>Electricity Act</i> (x1)
	(2) Did operate an electrical contracting business without holding a valid electrical contractor license, contrary to s.113.20(1)(d) of the <i>Electricity Act</i> (x1)
Date Charge Laid:	January 29, 2021
Plea:	Guilty plea on both charges
Disposition:	(1) Count #1: Guilty plea– advertising - Suspended Sentence.
	(2) Count #2: Guilty plea– operating as an electrical contractor \$3,000.00 + 750.00 (vsc)
Remarks:	<p>At the time the offences were committed, the Defendant was not a Licensed Electrical Contractor.</p> <p>Between the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 and the 11<sup>th</sup> of June, 2020, the Defendant advertised electrical services on Kijiji.ca.</p> <p>Further, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2020, the Defendant was operating as an electrical contractor while not the holder of a licensed electrical contractor license at a residence in the city of Mississauga.</p>
