Charge(s):	<p>(1) Did fail to file with ESA a Notification of Work for an electrical installation, contrary to s. 113.20(1)(a) of the <i>Electricity Act</i> (x1)</p> <p>(2) Did operate an electrical contracting business without holding a valid electrical contractor license, contrary to s.113.20(1)(d) of the <i>Electricity Act</i> (x1)</p>
Date Charge Laid:	September 2, 2021
Plea:	Guilty plea on both charges
Disposition:	<p>(1) Guilty plea entered – Failed to Apply for Inspection – Suspended Sentence;</p> <p>(2) Guilty plea entered – Operating as a licensed electrical contractor – \$3,000.00 + 750.00 (vsc)</p> <p>6 months to pay the fines.</p>
Remarks:	<p>At the time the offences were committed, the Defendant was not a Licensed Electrical Contractor.</p> <p>Between the 17<sup>th</sup> of March, 2021 and the 24<sup>th</sup> of March, 2021, the Defendant failed to file a Notification of Work with ESA for the electrical installations performed at an Ottawa residence.</p> <p>Further, the Defendant was operating as an electrical contractor while not the holder of a licensed electrical contractor license.</p>
