Remarks:	<p>At the time the offences were committed, the Defendant was not a Licensed Electrical Contractor.</p> <p>Between July 1, 2019 and April 10, 2020, the Defendant performed electrical services/installations at two residential properties (Guelph & Toronto) while not a Licensed Electrical Contractor; and offered / contracted to perform electrical work/services/installations for home renovations at two other residences (Innisfil & Kitchener).</p>
