Date Charge Laid:	September 10, 2021
Plea:	Guilty plea on seven charges
Disposition:	<p>(1) Guilty plea entered on 3 failed to file for Notification of Work charges – Suspended Sentence on Counts #1, 5, 7.  Count #6 - \$3,000.00 + 750.00 (vsc)</p> <p>(2) Guilty plea entered on 4 Operating as a licensed electrical contractor charges – suspended sentence on Counts #2, 4, 6  Count #8 - \$3,000.00 + 750.00 (vsc)  1 year to pay the fines.</p>
Remarks:	<p>At the time the offences were committed, the Defendant was not a Licensed Electrical Contractor.</p> <p>Between the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 and the 5<sup>th</sup> of March, 2021,</p>

	<p>the Defendant failed to file a Notification of Work with ESA for the electrical installations performed at 3 Ottawa residences.</p>
