<b>Regulation Description</b>	<p><b>Randi Buckmaster</b> Being a Director/Officer of Advantage Electrical Solutions Inc.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Failed to take all reasonable care to prevent the corporation from committing an offence under ss.113.20(1)(a) of the Electricity Act, 1998, to wit, operating an electrical contracting business without being the holder of electrical contractor license, contrary to s.3 of O. Reg. 570/05, contrary to ss.113.20(4) of the Electricity Act, 1998. Buckmaster was fined \$3,000.</li> <li>Failed to take all reasonable care to prevent the corporation from committing an offence under ss.113.20(1)(a) of the Electricity Act, 1998, to wit, failed to file with the Electrical Safety Authority a completed Notification of Work for work performed on an electrical installation located at 161 Auckland Drive, contrary to Rule 2-004(1) of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code, contrary to ss.113.20(4) of the Electricity Act, 1998. Buckmaster was fined \$750.</li> </ol>
<b>Description of Contravention</b>	Buckmaster was an Officer / Director of Advantage Electrical Solutions Inc. (AES). Neither Buckmaster nor AES were authorized to perform electrical work.

	<p>Between April 24, 2022, and June 30, 2022, AES offered to complete electrical work on a home located at a residential property in Whitby. The electrical work consisted of the installation of exterior pot lights and other electrical devices inside of the home. Estimates for the project were provided to the homeowner on AES letterhead and a deposit was paid to Buckmaster.</p> <p>Buckmaster then personally preformed the electrical work on the property. No 'Notification of Work' was filed with the ESA for the electrical work before it began.</p>
<b>Additional Information (if necessary)</b>	<p>Buckmaster showed remorse and was cooperative during the prosecution, agreeing agreed to an early guilty plea.</p>
