Disposition:	<p>On July 24, 2017 as a result of the trial in absentia, Mr. John was found guilty of two offences as noted above.</p> <p>On October 11, 2017, the Defendant filed a Motion to appeal his conviction and sentence.</p> <p>The appeal was heard on November 2, 2018 by the Judge of the Ontario Court of Justice, Criminal Division. The Judge overturned the conviction and ordered a new trial.</p> <p>The trial date was set, however, the Defendant decided to enter a guilty plea instead. As a result, on March 29, 2019 the Defendant entered a guilty plea and was sentenced to:</p> <p>(1) \$3,000 fine plus \$750.00 costs</p>
